The purpose of this research study is to find *new* markers in genes (the parts of every cell in the body that hold the instructions for how our bodies look and act) that can help in finding improved ways to diagnose, treat, and prevent breast cancer in women. Breast cancer continues to be one of the most common cancers in the U.S. and researchers are working diligently to find new and improved ways to detect cancer at earlier stages and to eventually find a cure. This study is completely voluntary and consists of signing a consent form, answering a questionnaire and providing one saliva sample.
